Again this year, readers will use the Beanstack Tracker app to log their reading and activity throughout the season.

The kickoff party, sponsored by the Friends of the Ferndale Library, features fun activities and lawn games for kids. It will also have something beloved by all age groups: tacos. The Friends of the Ferndale Library invited Regina's Mexican Food Truck to roll up to the park (at 1615 Lewiston Avenue) during the kickoff, just in case anyone needs a late lunch or an incentivizing snack before or after signing up. Treat Dreams will also be on the scene, providing free ice cream to anyone signing up for Summer Reading. Plus, folk musician Terry Murphy will perform a special set of Beatles covers at 1:30 pm. Families can also check out the newest picture book featured in our **Story Trail**, set along the walking path on the west end of the park, leading up to the Curling Club building.

This year's Summer Reading theme of *All Together Now* is a celebration of community—a way to encourage everyone in Ferndale to read **together!** Different challenges are available based on the reader's age: Early Readers (ages 0-4) | Kids (ages 5-12) | Teens (ages 13-18) | Adults (ages 18+). Each age group has a unique set of reading requirements and/or activities to complete before the Summer Reading finale on August 12.
