FERNDALE, MI (November 21, 2023—) The Ferndale Area District Library is hosting its final concert of the year on Friday, December 1, featuring the breathtakingly talented Detroit-based singer/songwriter Libby DeCamp. This free, all-ages concert will be hosted after regular library hours, with the building's doors opening at 7:30 pm, and live music beginning promptly at 8:00 pm, performed inside the library's programming room, which faces bustling Nine Mile Road.

The Ferndale Library has been hosting monthly concerts for nearly 14 consecutive years, with their ongoing live local music showcase known as *First Stop Friday*. Located in the heart of downtown Ferndale, the library staff are well aware that most music fans have quite a lot of options, given the close proximity of other venues and bars, but the idea is to consider this event to be one's *first stop* of the evening—a free and exceedingly more intimate listening experience than your average bar, where listeners can engage with some of the best up-and-coming and established artists around the metro area.

Libby DeCamp is a singer, songwriter, and multi-instrumentalist based in Detroit. Her songs evoke the spirit of roots music from bygone eras, drawing inspiration from pre-war blues, old-time string bands, early R&B, and country western. Her latest releases have become more tonally and even atmospherically focused—or perhaps the best summary can be borrowed from her Bandcamp pages: "...deep-diving time-tracing cinematic folk blues ramblings."
