Drawing comparisons to Woody Guthrie, Bob Dylan, and even a little bit of Tom Waits, Boutette will indeed please fans of all folk styles, whether classic or modern. Kristi Lynn Davis' natural gift for harmony instantly brought new life to Boutette's celebrated catalog of songs, as evidenced by their recent releases Easy as Pie and Seven Stars Around the Moon.

Boutette's songs of highway hijinks and wildcat oil drillers in the Michigan woods are as likely to be heard as old favorites that have been in your head and heart for years.
